






#### ELECTORS' DATA 2024 Vs 2019

## **EVM/VVPAT**

EVM & VVPAT machines of M3 Model are available in the state.

#### **POSTAL BALLOT**

As per the direction of ECI, the absentee voters of the following categories are eligible for postal ballot.

- Senior citizens (above 85 years of age).
  - Persons with disability.
- COVID-19-suspected or affected Persons.
  - Electors on essential duties

The above categories of citizens wishing to vote by postal ballot must make an application to the Returning Officer (RO) of the constituency concerned, in Form-12D, within five days of issue of notification.

The Service Voters will be sent ETPBMS (Electronically Transmitted Postal Ballot Management System) on which they will record their vote and send it back through post.

Voters on election duty will also be eligible to vote through postal ballot in the facilitation centers set up by the Returning Officer.

#### FILING OF NOMINATIONS



Online Nomination facility through SUVIDHA Portal

Candidates have to file affidavits relating to assets and liabilities of self and family members, Government dues pending, criminal antecedents, etc. including details of personal social media accounts.



If the candidate has any criminal antecedent - either pending cases or cases in which the candidate has been convicted, then he shall have to publicize such details of his/her criminal cases in newspaper and television channels thrice during the campaign period in the prescribed format.



Recognized parties and registered un-recognized parties, which set up candidates with criminal cases, either pending cases or cases of past conviction, are required to publish declarations giving details in this regard on their website as well as in TV channels and newspapers having wide circulation in Odisha.

#### MODEL CODE OF CONDUCT



With the announcement of the Simultaneous General Election the Model Code of Conduct has come into force with immediate effect in the entire State.

All the provisions of the Model Code of Conduct will apply to all candidates, political parties and, the State Government & the Union Government.



Elaborate arrangements have been made for ensuring the effective implementation of the MCC Guidelines. Any violations of these Guidelines would be strictly dealt with. Citizens can report instances of MCC violation using C-VIGIL App.

#### **ELECTION EXPENDITURE MONOTORING**

Maximum limit of election expenditure for the candidate for Assembly Constituencies is **Rs. 40.00** Lakh and for Parliamentary Constituencies is **Rs.95.00** Lakh.

Flying Squads (FS), Static Surveillance Teams (SST), Video Surveillance Teams (VST), VVT etc

All concerned Central/State Enforcement Agencies have been asked to keep a close watch to ensure inducement(cash)/liquor/freebies for free and fair elections.

All candidates are required to furnish their correctly maintained registers for accounts of expenditure within 30 days of the declaration of results.




